

## Competitor Information for Longview I and II May 1-2, 2021

Hours:

- a. Friday 1:00 PM - 6:30 PM
  - b. Saturday 7:00 AM - 6:30 PM
  - c. Sunday 7:00 AM - end of show
2. Scores are available on HORSESHOWOFFICE.COM as soon as the test is scored in the office.
  3. Camping is NOT allowed. Angie and Ron Cumberford will be on the grounds overnight and will monitor the horses. Their numbers are 816-520-0512 and 816-935-6160 in case of emergency.
  4. Rings: Ring 1 is farthest from the warmup. Ring 2 is closest to the warmup.
  5. Our Technical Delegate is Susan Lang.

Information regarding Covid guidelines:

- Anyone who exhibits COVID-19 symptoms, has tested positive for COVID-19 within last two weeks, or \*has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks cannot enter the competition grounds. \*Exception: Healthcare personnel who have treated patients using appropriate medical grade PPE during the course of performing professional duties are exempted from this restriction. PLEASE stay home if you feel sick.

- Participants and their support crew are required to self-monitor their temperature once daily prior to entering. ANYONE with a temperature over 100.4°F cannot enter the competition grounds

- All participants, including licensed officials and volunteers, must provide emergency contact information and execute an updated Waiver and Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement required by USEF, as a condition of participation

- All staff, officials, volunteers, service providers and participants are required to wear a facemask or face covering AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON COMPETITION GROUNDS when not mounted on a horse. Mounted riders may wear a face covering without penalty · Spectators and guests (general public and individuals not directly involved in the competition) will not be permitted. One guardian is allowed per rider who is a minor. Limit of 3 people per horse at the gate.

- All attendees are required to social distance by a minimum of six feet, and congregating is not allowed. The only exception is members of the same immediate household.

- A staff member may patrol the barn areas to remind people to stay six feet apart from

each other and to wear masks at all times.

- Hand sanitizer and disinfectant will be available in high use areas such as the show office, in-gates, rest rooms and warm-up rings.
- Stalling charts will be created using as much space as possible between barns and tack rooms.
- Food will be available for purchase. Bottled water will be available.
- Competitors may not report to their warmup area more than one hour before their ride time.
- The number of horses in the warmup area may need to be limited.
- PLEASE make sure your entry is complete. Show office access will be limited, so any changes may take more time than anticipated. Also, the USEF encourages minimal physical handling of paperwork.
- The Competition Organizer has the authority under GR 702.1 and GR914 to remove from the facility any person who does not comply with the regulations and requirements in effect at the competition.
