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ENTERING THE SHOW:

1. ONLINE at Horse Show Office

- Go to www.horsheshowoffice.com to enter online. After entering and paying, download the entry and upload the Entry Form signature page and Coggins Report to Horse Show Office to complete the entry.
- A confirmation email will be sent from Horse Show Office to the email address provided and include a link if documents or payment are required.

2. MAILED to the Show Manager

Payment can be made by check made payable to **Charleston Equestrian Center, LLC** and included with the mailed entry. Returned checks will incur a \$50 fee. 3. EMAILED to the Show Manager

- Email the signed entry form and Coggins to: frelighc2805@gmail.com. Emailed entries will incur an additional fee (\$5) due to the added administrative costs. Payment can be through Paypal at [paypal.me/ridehorses4280](https://www.paypal.me/ridehorses4280) as the URL for the internet address. Can also mail a check made payable to Charleston Equestrian Center, LLC and mail to: Carol Freligh, 1621 Middendorf Road, Hartsville, SC 29550. Returned checks will incur a \$50 fee.

Awards:

- All classes will be separated into Seniors and Junior/Young Riders if there are at least 3 or more riders in the class.
- First through Sixth place ribbons will be awarded.
- A Dressage High Score Prize & Ribbon will be awarded to the SCDCTA Member / SCDCTA Reg. Horse Pair with the highest score (Classes 1 through 12). A Combined Training Low Score Prize & Ribbon will be awarded to the SCDCTA Member / SCDCTA Reg. Horse Pair with the lowest score (Classes 13 through 18). Attire: An ASTM Approved helmet must be worn AT ALL TIMES when mounted and footwear should have a distinguishable heel while riding. Otherwise, casual attire is acceptable.

Arenas: Two (20m x 40m) dressage arenas will be used for Classes 1-3 and 13-19, 25-26. Two (20m x 60m) dressage arena will be used for Classes 4-12 and 20. A separate jumping arena will be used for combined test stadium and jumpers.

Guest Horses: Horses **NOT** entered in classes but attending the show must have a completed entry form (for each horse) by the closing date (3/7/21) and a current negative Coggins Report included. The Liability clause must be signed by rider/handler of the horse on the entry form. The fees for each guest horse are \$20.00 and a \$10.00 office fee (add \$5 to the office fee if entry is emailed.) Each guest horse is required to wear a number when off the trailer or out of a stall. The number is obtained at the Check-in Table. Late fees apply if requested after 3/7/21.

MPEC April 17, 2021 Championship Schooling Show:

All competitors are welcome to show their horses in the regular classes normally offered at Middleton Place Equestrian Center during the MPEC April 17, 2021 Championship Schooling Show. Horse/Rider Pairs that are **eligible for championship classes** will



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be notified by email by the opening date of the show. Championship classes will be listed separately on the April 17, 2021 Schooling Show prizelist.

Eligibility requirements:

- Participation in two of the four shows qualifies a rider/horse pair to compete in the MPEC April 2021 Championship Schooling Show classes.
- Rider and horse must show as a pair throughout the MPEC show series. Show dates are 9/19/2020, 11/7/2020, 1/9/2021 & 3/13/2021.
- A rider/horse pair can compete and become eligible in both Dressage, Combined Training, Jumpers and DSE.
- A rider/horse pair may only compete in the Championship class(es) for which they are eligible based upon the level(s) shown at the MPEC Show Series listed above.
- Championship classes will be separated into Jr/YR and Sr divisions. Championship classes include: Introductory through Fourth Level Dressage Tests, Amoeba through Training Combined Tests, Intro Jumpers through High Jumpers, DSE W/T and DSE W/T/C if there are at least three eligible riders for the class.

Awards:

- Champion, Reserve Champion and 3rd through 6th place ribbons will be awarded. Trophies/awards are TBD.
