Attire: An ASTM Approved helmet must be worn AT ALL TIMES when mounted and footwear should have a distinguishable heel while riding. Otherwise, casual attire is acceptable.

Arenas: A (20m x 40m) dressage arena will be used for all CT Dressage, USEA TOC, and Introductory Level Dressage tests. A (20m x 60m) dressage arena will be used for the Musical Freestyle Exhibition, Costume Class, Training Level through FEI Dressage, Dressage Seat Equitation and Leadline classes. A separate outdoor jumping arena will be used for combined test stadium rounds. Dressage tests (CT and Dressage) will be in covered arena unless entries warrant then a second outdoor arena will also be used

Non-Competing Horses: Horses **NOT** entered in classes but attending the show must have a completed entry form (for each horse) by the closing date (10/20/21) and a current negative EIA-Coggins Report submitted with the entry. The Entry Agreement must be signed by rider/handler of the horse. Each non-competing horse is required to wear a number when off the trailer or out of a stall.

Grounds/Haul-ins: This fee is assessed for all horses that are trailered in and do **not** have a stall reserved. Horses may **NOT** be tied to or left in trailers overnight.

Night Watch/Braiding: All competitors will be emailed one week before the show to sign up for night watch and/or braiding. Horse must be stalled to use this service.

Office Hours and Fee: The Office Fee pays for administrative costs that include numbers, dressage tests, programs, and daysheets. The office opens at 12:00 pm on Friday, Oct. 29th and at 7:00 am on Saturday and Sunday. The office will be closed at 8:00 pm on Friday and at 7:00 pm on Saturday. The office will be closed on Sunday one hour after the last class is completed. All horses must be checked in and received a bridle number before being mounted.

Schooling and Lunging: Schooling may begin at 12:30 pm on Friday, Oct. 29th. All horses are required to wear a bridle number when out of the stall whether being led, are mounted or tied to a trailer. No one may enter the competition arenas after 4:00 pm on Friday, Oct. 29th. Lunging is only allowed in the designated Lunging area. Lunging is not allowed in the warmup arenas. No horses are allowed in the competition arenas (Dressage and Jumping) Saturday or Sunday. Warmup arenas for both dressage will be designated and may be used anytime Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Arenas with jumps will be closed to riders on Sunday.

Scratches from Show / Classes: Scratches before the closing date (Oct. 20th) will be refunded in full. **No** refund after the closing date.

Ride Times and Stall Assignments: Times and stabling assignments will be emailed to the email address on the entry form by 10/26/21. Please contact the show secretary, Carol Freligh, carol@scdcta.com or 843-857-6229 if you have questions. Stabling requests should be noted on the entry. Extra shavings may be purchased for \$6.00 by indicating the number on the entry or requesting additional shavings during the show. Extra shavings must be purchased at the SC Equine Park.

Stabling: All stalls have been refurbished and have full rubber matting. Requests to stable with a group should be indicated on the entry form. Other specific stabling requests (for example: Stallion needs an end stall) should be indicated on the entry form.

RV Hookup: There are 50- and 30-amp RV sites. Any cord connected will be considered a hook-up per SCEP management and will be charged a hookup fee.

Halloween Schooling Show Saturday and Sunday Morning: These classes are open to all competitors and SCDCTA membership is **NOT** required.

Saturday Costume Class: This class is open to all. Riders may be led, lead the horse or ride the horse. If riding the horse, rider must wear an ASTM approved helmet and footwear with a distinguishable heel. This class will be held after the Championship Classes on Saturday. Prizes will be TBD.

Friday Musical Freestyle: This class is open to all. Musical Freestyle tests can be any level and the rider can dress-up or wear conventional dressage clothing but must wear an ASTM approved helmet and footwear with a distinguishable heel. This class will be held Friday evening with the first ride at 5:00 pm in the covered arena. The movements should be traditional dressage but do not have to stay within the level. Indicate the level (Introductory through FEI Levels) when entering this class, for example: First Level. Please bring a CD or thumb drive with your music as a MP3 file. A check of your music will be done before the exhibition on Friday between noon and 4pm. Please check in at the show office with your music. Entry and office fee, stabling or haul in fees apply. Prizes will be TBD.

Stall Decorating Contest: Decorated stalls will be judged each day (Saturday and Sunday.) Prizes are TBD

National Dressage Pony Cup (NDPC) TOC (Class 25): All ponies are welcome to enter this class. NDPC membership is **NOT** required to enter this class but is encouraged to allow pony and rider to be eligible for NDPC's year-end award program. When entering this class, please indicate the Level and Test to be performed. A pony is considered 14.3 hands or smaller. A USEF Pony Measurement Card is **NOT** required for this class. Measurement of the pony is at the discretion of the show manager if a USEF Pony Measurement Card is not available. If the pony already has a USEF Pony Measurement Card, **please** include it as part of your entry or show the card to the show office when checking in. If your pony does not have a USEF Pony Measurement Card, the show management will do an informal measurement at the show. Please make an appointment with the show manager to have the pony measured on the show grounds prior to entering the NDPC Pony TOC class. See the last page of prizelist for information about becoming a member of NDPC and eligibility for their championship show and year end awards.

2021 Championship Classes (Saturday and Sunday afternoon) Eligibility requirements:

- Rider and horse must be eligible for 2021 SCDCTA Schooling Show Year End Awards. (Volunteer hour requirements are **not** required to enter Championship classes.)
 - Dressage – 3 Tests (1 must be from the highest test of the level). Minimum score of 57% as the median. Tests should be from two different judges.
 - Combined Training – 3 CTs with two of the CTs from different judges.
- A rider/horse pair can compete and become eligible in both Dressage and Combined Training.
- Eligibility requirements may be completed during the Halloween Schooling Show morning classes. Exception to this rule is a horse may **not** compete in more than 2 CT classes per day and in more than 3 Dressage classes per day, which includes the championship class.
- SCDCTA membership and lifetime horse registration will be accepted through the closing date (October 20th). Memberships and/or horse registrations for the championship classes will **not** be accepted after October 20th. NO EXCEPTIONS.

NDPC Partner Show Sponsored by Mad Kat Dressage

Each Partner Show awards two ribbons for High Point and Reserve High Point. These ribbons are presented to winning competitors AT THE SHOW based on the results of pony-only classes.

To be eligible for NDPC Pony Year-End Awards, each pony/rider and horse/rider combination must become members of the NDPC Pony Division. Ponies must have a current valid USEF Pony Measurement on file with the USEF submitted to the NDPC by October 31.

There is no minimum or maximum number of scores required to be eligible. All scores from any USDF sanctioned show will count toward Year-End Awards. Ponies may compete at more than one level with the same rider, as long as the levels are consecutive. Non-members are not eligible for Year-End Awards.

Scores will have a degree of difficulty figured in per test and then will be averaged. High Point is given to the highest single score without degree of difficulty points added. Our show year is November 1 – October 31.

The National Dressage Pony Cup showcases the exceptional talent, training, and commitment of ponies, their owners, breeders, trainers, and riders in the art and sport of dressage. NDPC encourages competition at every level, for riders of any ability of age, and ponies of any breed of mix of breeds to compete and enjoy their experience.

The NDPC partners with USDF shows around the country to offer our Partner Show Program. These shows will offer at least one 'pony only' class, but possibly more, and an opportunity to receive your USEF Pony Measurement card. You do not need to be a member to compete in a Partner Show.
