**Introductory**, Green As Grass, and other walk/trot classes are open to horse/rider combinations that have not earned three scores of 60% or above in any test at any dressage show.

**Novice Rider** classes are open to riders who have not earned six scores of 60% or above in any test at Training Level or above at any dressage show. No limits on experience of horse.

**Junior** riders are those 17 years or younger as of Dec. 1, 2003.

**Novice Horse** classes are open to all horses that have not earned six scores of 60% or above in any test at Training Level or above with any rider at any dressage show.

**Intermediate Rider** classes are open to riders who have not earned six scores of 60% or above in any test at First Level or above in any dressage show.

**Open** classes are open to any horse or rider.

**Dressage Equitation** is open to any rider who has not competed over Second Level.

**Suitable to Become a Dressage Horse** is open to any horse that has not competed over First Level.

**Bareback classes:** Specify test on entry form. Class 7 any walk-trot test offered; class 43 any test Training-Fourth Level.

**Ride-a-Buck:** Group class ridden bareback. Entry fee is \$1, which is placed under the seat of the rider. The last person to have the dollar bill wins all dropped money.

**Entries:** Entry fee is \$20 per class. Make checks payable to **ADA**. Mail entries to **Bradbury Management, 433 Cambridge Dr., Dexter, MI 48130**. Entries postmarked after the closing date will be subject to \$10 post entry fee per class. If using express mail, waive signature. A "no show" for a class will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and times may be filled. Full refunds less the office fee on or before closing date. **NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE.**

**Faxed entries** accepted with a valid Visa or MasterCard. Fax entry to (734) 426-5618. Payment processing fee of \$5 (discounted for check and cash payments) must be included if paying with Visa or MasterCard.

**On-line entries** accepted at [www.HorseShowOffice.com](http://www.HorseShowOffice.com). A signed waiver and copy of Coggins must be mailed or faxed at least two weeks prior to the show.

**Test of Choice Classes:** Specify test on entry. May be split by test regardless of number of entries. Riders may ride more than one test but cannot ride the same test twice.

**Awards:** Trophy and six ribbons per class. Champion and Reserve ribbons awarded for High Point and High Percentage in each of the following: Junior and Senior Intro/Green As Grass; Jr. Novice, Sr. Novice, Open, and Novice Horse Training Level; Intermediate and Open First Level; and Open Second Level.

**Times** will be emailed if email address is provided on entry. Ride times also available at [www.HorseShowOffice.com](http://www.HorseShowOffice.com) or by phone Thursday before show.

**Arenas/Footing:** Five 20m x 60m competition arenas; two large warm up areas – all-weather sand. PVC board dressage arenas – no chain arenas. Intro and Green As Grass will be run in short arena. All other tests will be run in standard arena.

**Stabling:** \$30 per stall. Permanent wooden stalls, 10' x 10' with half doors or temporary vinyl stalls with full door. No initial bedding; can purchase shavings on grounds for \$7/bale or on entry for \$5/bale. \$20 haul-in fee for horses not stabled.

**Coggins:** No horse will be admitted to the show grounds without a legible negative Coggins, with same name as on entry, drawn no earlier than December 1, 2003.

**Camper Hook Up:** \$20, include fee with entry.

**Restrooms:** Permanent restroom facilities with showers on grounds.

**Food:** Food service on grounds. Retail trade concessions also available. Contact Show Manager for information on concession space and program advertising.

**Accommodations:** Holiday Inn Express 734-433-1600. Located off I-94, exit 159, ten miles from show grounds. Ask for Waterloo Dressage rate. Contact show secretary for additional hotels.

**Directions:** From I-94, exit No. 150 (Grass Lake). Turn North and then turn right on Glenn Road (third road). Waterloo Hunt is on the left in approximately one mile. Showgrounds are at the back of the property.
