- 2) **East Coast Riders Cup Champion and Reserve Champion** and ribbons to six places to the highest combined scores of the two rides for each USEF division and PSG/I1 and I2/GP for FEI divisions Tests may be read. Whips are allowed. Rules are found further in this Prizelist.
- 3) **Bluegrass Bear JR Challenge, sponsored by Renee Isler** – six ribbons, and great prizes at each level Training thru 4th. Rules are found further in this Prizelist.
- 4) **Mitchell Retirement Farm Senior Horse Award** – For Horses 18 and older, score from Fri & Sat, level and age are considerations.

These are two different shows and two entries are required. All entries **MUST** submit applicable USEF and USDF documents for rider, owner, trainer and horse, a negative Coggins dated within 12 months of show, proof of EIV and EHV vaccinations dated within six months of the show, a drug fee, and non-refundable office fee. All USEF memberships, horse recordings and show passes (GR206) must be done before the show as none can be done at the show. Please include USDF non-member fee if applicable. All entries must have three signatures and also emergency info for rider in case of injury to rider on the entry form. In addition, USEF waiver must be signed by all parties on the entry. Checks payable to **HITS, Inc** or fill out Credit Card info on the entry form. American Express, Mastercard and Visa accepted. Entries can be mailed, emailed or online via www.HorseShowOffice.com. Emailed or online entries are only accepted with CC as payment. Post entries will be accepted to fill scratches with a \$50 post entry fee on www.HorseShowOffice.com. Completed entries will be processed in the order they are received. Refunds will be given for cancellations received in writing or emailed on or before the closing date less office fee. All refund will be done after the show. **Unconditionally, no refunds after closing date or for 'acts of god' which require management to cancel classes or day(s) of competition.** Any unused USEF or USDF fees will be refunded after any indebtedness is settled.

Times: Times will be on the website, www.hitsshows.com and www.horseshowoffice.com, at least one week prior to the competition and updated times will be posted online at www.horseshowoffice.com by noon on Thursday. Please email or upload music and sign up for sound checks online with secretary. IF CDs are the only method, music must be in MP3 or WAV formats, and CDs will NOT be returned.

Stabling: Permanent stalls 12'x12' (minimum) with full doors is \$275 for duration for open show. No initial bedding. Please note your stabling group on your entry. **No refunds on stabling after closing.** May arrive on Wednesday after 1 pm, must vacate by 7pm Sunday. Earlier arrivals and later departures must get permission from management and \$65/night fee. Bedding is TBD bag. Pre-ordered before 8/13 to have at your stall and at the show order by text or email to show secretary. Hay available for TBD/bale. Paddocks available for \$300.

Directions:

From the North: Take I-87 (NY State Thruway) to Exit 20 – Saugerties. Turn right on Rt 32 N
*Travel 0.5 mi past Peoples Rd to 'Y' intersection. Bear right at 'Y' intersection to County Rt 34 and go 0.1 mi to 4-way stop. Turn right onto Malden Turnpike/County Rt 34. Go 1.6 mi to stop sign at intersection for Rt 9W. Turn right onto Rt 9W South. Go 0.4 mi to Krout Rd. Turn right onto Krout Rd – Caution! This is a steep downhill grade. HITS will be on your left at the base of the hill. Turn in at Gate A.

From the South: Take I-87 (NY State Thruway) to Exit 20 – Saugerties. Turn left at traffic light after tollbooth. Immediately move into the right lane and bear right onto Rt 32 North. Follow directions from '*'.

Footing: All classes are scheduled in large (20m X 60m) sand arenas. Sand warm up arenas. Separate Lunging area.

Entertainment: Food available on the grounds beginning 7am each day.

Other: Farrier on the grounds, (518)751-6148. Veterinarian on call, and contact info will be posted, (845)876-7085. All dogs must be leashed. Management reserves the right to combine, divide, or cancel classes or championships specified in this prize list.

For Pony measurement, the owner or agent must notify competition management and/or competition secretary, and request a measurement within five days of the start of the competition (8/8). Up to a \$100 fee maybe incurred for the cost of the veterinarian.

SHOW AND EVENT MANAGEMENT

Bluegrass Bear JrYR Challenge Sponsored by Renee Isler

The Bluegrass Bear JrYR Challenge, AAC, is a qualifying and riding program for JrYR only. It is very simple. Here are the simple...VERY simple rules!

Horse Requirements

1. None!

Rider Requirements

1. Rider needs to be an JrYR by the USEF age rule for dressage..
2. Rider qualifying for Training and First Levels may not have ridden above 3rd level at recognized show. Rider qualifying for Second and Third Levels may not have ridden above PSG at recognized show. Rider qualifying for Fourth Level may not have ridden above I1 at recognized show.

Challenge

1. Horse and Rider combination enter the challenge at Centerline Events @ HITS in August. The combination may ride two consecutive levels or the rider may qualify two horses at two consecutive levels. Maximum levels a rider may enter is two.
2. Combination will ride Dressage Seat Equitation and highest test of the level, ie Training Test 3, First Test 3, etc.
3. Tests may be read and whips are allowed.
4. Combined scores will determine the place. In the case of the tie, the higher DSE score will break the tie. If still tie, then they remain tied and if prize money is involved, it will be combined and/or divided accordingly.

Awards

For each class, ie DSE and Dressage Test, three ribbons will be awarded. For the combined scores there will be six place medals. Other Prizes TBA plus prize money.

SHOW AND EVENT MANAGEMENT

East Coast Rider's Cup

The East Coast Rider's Cup, ECRC, was created in 1993 to promote recognition of the competitors and their mounts. By combining the two highest tests of the level, it shows a true champion who maintains that level of excellence through both rides.

In 2022, it has been changed by combining two rides at the highest test of the level and for FEI by combining PSG/I1 and I2/GP for the championships.

Awards:

There will be one Champion and one Reserve champion plus third thru sixth placings for each division, ie Training, First....The Champion and Reserve Champion will receive a ribbon, prize money (see below) and other prizes (TBA). Third thru sixth place will receive ribbon.

Requirements:

1. Open to all competitors residing anywhere on the planet earth and open to horses of any breed, sex, size or color.
2. Same horse/rider combination for both tests.
3. For Training through Fourth levels, the two rides at the highest test of the level will be ridden, one each day. For the FEI levels, two tests of the PSG/I1 level will be ridden and two tests of the I2/GP, ie one PSG and one I1, one each day. Both tests must be ridden to be part of the championship.
4. The placing will be determined by the combined total of the percentage score from both rides.
5. Ties will be broken on combined collective marks. If further tie breaker is needed, the score of the highest test of the level, then highest test collective marks. If still remained tie, then place remains tied and prizes will be combined and them split according to the USEF rules.
6. USEF Rules for riding the tests must be followed. Whips and Readers are allowed.
7. The same score may also be used as a qualifier for the USDF/GAIG Regional Championships with the correct fee to management. Please check prize list and note on entry form.
