All entries will be online (www.horseshowoffice.com) ONLY prepaid by PayPal or online check only. All documents must be uploaded to www.horseshowoffice.com, emailed to entries@scriptsrider.com or fax to 540-301-8166. No paperwork will be accepted at the show! You must have a complete entry (all paperwork and payment) to receive ride times. Paperwork needed: Signed Entry form (rider & parent if junior), Current Coggins Test; Current Flu/Rhino Vaccine Record (within 6 months of the show). **No cash refunds after closing date.**

Everyone (riders, handlers, assistant handlers, owners/agents, trainers, coaches, officials, staff, volunteers and any others) MUST sign a USEF waiver form (posted on vada-ch website).

Show Information

- Ride Times: Ride times will be posted on horseshowoffice.com. Jump time window to be assigned & posted on www.VADA-CH.org, emailed and posted at the show.
- The show will be run entirely OUTDOORS. Parking in field, please work off your trailer, no stalls in barn!
- Warm-up: Dressage will be in the indoor arena and stadium warm-up jumps will be in a designated grass area.
- Competition Arenas: All dressage tests will be ridden in a sand arena. USEA tests will be ridden in a 20X40 (Small) arena. Stadium jumps will be in a sand arena. Do to jumping warm-up being on the grass, all riders will be allowed to jump fences 1 & 2 as an in course warm-up before they start their course and are judged.
- Cross-Country Schooling Available: After finish competing, the cross-country field is open for schooling at no additional cost. Please let us know at registration if you will be planning on schooling cross-country. Safety vest must be worn and you MUST have a ground person present when you enter the course.
- Any rider jumping must suitable helmet, safety vest (cross country schooling) and medical armband.
- Awards:
 - Classes pinned Open & Jr, first through sixth place.
 - A Dressage High Score Prize and Ribbon will be awarded.
 - A Combined Training Low Score Prize and Ribbon will be awarded.

- There will be no food or beverages - complimentary water and snacks available.
- Dogs: If you bring them, they must be of a pleasant nature and please ensure they are leashed.
- Riders interested in the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program: when you enter online, please the following numbers available: USDF for Rider, Owner, Horse. If you are a VADA-CH or any VADA Chapter member, you are a USDF Group member. If you are interested & your horse does not have a USDF number, you only need a USDF HID number.
- Fees: Payable to VADA-CH, online entries (Check & PayPal – no account needed) only accepted at horseshowoffice.com
 - \$10.00 Office fee (includes bridle number fee)
 - Dressage Test Only: VADA-CH Member: \$30.00; VADA-CH Non-Member: \$40.00 (will be charged the non-member additional fee at the show if rider hasn't joined by then) and Combined Test: \$50.00. Extra jump rounds at your level for an additional fee of \$15.00.
 - No refunds after the Closing date for any reason including cancellations due to Acts of God, acts of terrorism, inclement weather, and/or other emergencies.
