Ride times will be posted on the show website on Tuesday, August 29.

Stall assignments will be posted on the show website by Thursday, August 31 and will also be posted at the show by 9:00 AM on Friday, September 1. Pre-ordered stall bedding will not be distributed until the arrival day listed on the entry form. The price is: **\$10.00/bag of shavings.** Please email Bettina Longaker with shavings orders. **Horses should not arrive before Friday morning unless early arrival has been approved. Check-in at the show office and schooling starts at Friday noon!**

The show office is located in the main coliseum. Office hours: Noon-7pm Friday, 7am-6pm Saturday, 7am-1 hour after show ends on Sunday. **Packets can be picked up at the show office starting at NOON on Friday.**

The “Roasted and Toasted” food truck will be on the grounds both days from 8:00 am – 3:00 pm. Karyn Becerra and Iron Horse Farm are sponsoring a Welcome Wagon Pizza Party in the barns starting around 6:00 pm on Friday. Brookside Farm is sponsoring coffee, pastries and Mimosas each morning. The N.C. Dept. of Agriculture requires that a copy of a current **NEGATIVE COGGINS** test be available to the State Veterinarian’s office for each horse entering the facility. Exhibitors **MUST** post a copy of the Coggins on the horse’s stall door or trailer if you are not stabled. Any equine without a negative Coggins test will immediately be quarantined back to its point of origin. **NO horses (including non-competing horses) will be permitted on the grounds unless they have registered prior to arrival with the secretary and submitted a current negative Coggins test. Also, you must show documentation of your horse’s Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months of the show.**

Day parking is allowed around Barn F or between the camper area and the long outside ring. Horses will be stabled in Barns B & E. Trailers must be parked in the trailer parking area adjacent to Trinity Road. **DO NOT** park trailers beside/between the barns!!

HEADGEAR RULE FOR DRESSAGE

From the time horses are officially admitted to the competition grounds by competition management, anyone mounted on a horse at any time on the competition grounds, including non-competing riders, riders on non-competing horses, and those competing in all classes and tests, including Para-Equestrian tests, must wear protective headgear. **Handlers, assistant handlers and whip assistants of any age must wear protective headgear while handling or assisting in the competition ring.**

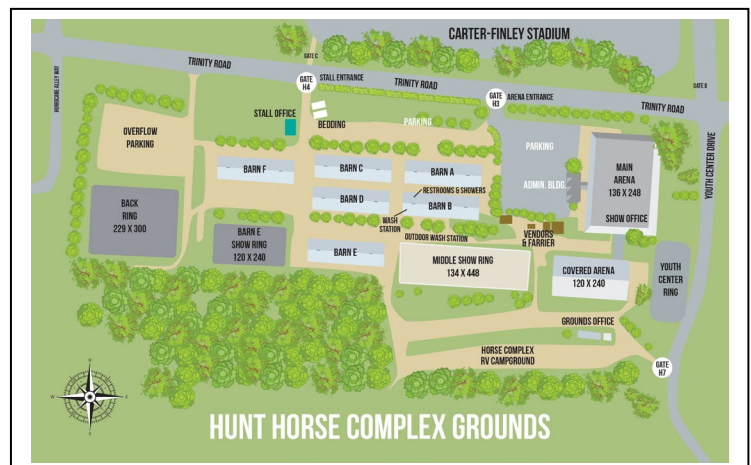
