Open Show: No qualifying, NCDCTA recognized for HOY points, everyone is welcome!

Championship Show:

To qualify for the championship classes, compete in at least 6 classes (within the qualifying level) and 3 different participating shows. <https://www.ncsandboxseries.com/championship-show.html>

Competitors can qualify/compete in two consecutive levels.

Championship Competition will feature two days (Saturday and Sunday, specific class each day) of competition with the two scores for each competitor to be averaged to determine placings. Must compete in both classes in order to be eligible for placing in Championship.

Horses can compete in separate divisions with separate riders (do not have to be consecutive).

Each championship division will be awarded 1st-5th with neck ribbons and prizes for Champion and Reserve.

Guest Horses: (*non-competing*) Submit signed entry form, negative coggins, proof of vaccination, pay guest horse fee, office fee plus either stabling or day parking. Guest horses should avoid crowded warm up arenas, priority given to competing horses. No late fees charged on guest horses.

Refunds: *Before closing date*, less office fee. **After CD:** any paid extra bedding refunded for notified scratches **prior to show**; no refunds for no-shows. If show has to be canceled for any reason, refund less EMT/Office fee. **All refunds will be less 5% processing fee.**

Bounced check policy: \$40 fee; entry wait listed until payment settled.

PayPal/Credit Card dispute: \$70 charge per dispute, chargeback and/or withdrawal.

AWARDS:

OPEN SHOW

- Ribbons through sixth place in all classes, **trophy for classes/divisions with 2 or more**. Classes will be split by test and/or division as entries warrant.

CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

Championship classes will be placed with ribbons through sixth place and a prize for first place. Each championship division (averaged scores) will be awarded 1st-5th with prizes for neck ribbons and prizes for Champion and Reserve. STABLING:

- Permanent stalls with door in center aisle barns. All stalls at least 10 x 10. Two bags of bedding are included with stall, **extra bedding should be ordered in advance (\$10)**. There will be a **very limited quantity** of extra bedding available at the show and it will be \$11 per bag.
- **Do not place items in empty stalls – a stall will be charged to anyone who does so.**
- There are a **very limited number of paddocks available** on a first come basis. It is encouraged that groups share paddocks. Paddock may not be close to the barn assigned. Paddocks are only available for those who also get a horse stall.

TIMES:

- Ride times will be available by Wednesday before the show and will be posted online at www.horsehowoffice.com **Riders should recheck their ride times the night before the show as times may change!**
- **Riders assume responsibility for reviewing entry confirmation to verify correct information and classes; management not responsible for errors, omissions.**

CAMPERS: Limited camper spots are available for \$50/night for the weekend. All have power and some have water. There is no dump station on site. **Camper spots assigned on a first come basis.**

DIRECTIONS: **GPS Address:** 200 Beulah Hill Rd. S. Pinehurst NC 28374.
Pinehurst Harness Track is located on N.C. 5 in Pinehurst, N.C. *From North:* US 1 South, exit at Morganton Road in Southern Pines, turn west (right) toward Pinehurst. Follow Morganton to end, turn South (left) on NC 5. Harness Track entrance is first left. *From the West,* take US 220 (I 73/74 corridor) to NC 211 east towards Pinehurst. Turn right at NC 5, Harness Track is 1.7 miles on left. Watch 35 mph speed limit here, Pinehurst police are vigilant! *From South:* US 1 to Aberdeen, turn left (West) on NC 5 to Harness Track, entrance approx. 6 miles on right, just beyond stoplight at Monticello Rd.

ARENAS: Two or three 20 X 60 competition arenas on all-weather screenings/sand footing. Warm up is screenings/sand area plus acres of aerated turf with natural sand base.

HOSPITALITY: Bottled water will be available outside of show office and in the warm up area, with the stewards. Food truck will be onsite Saturday and Sunday.

Entry Information:

All entries must have signatures on release form – Rider, Legal Guardian must sign for riders under 18 yrs must sign entry agreement.

No horse will be permitted on the grounds without a valid negative coggins test within 1 year of show. Horses should be vaccinated for flu/rhino within 6 months of show date.

Entries must be **received** by Midnight of the closing date.

Entries received after closing date will be considered late and if accepted a late fee will be applied, see below.

Refunds: Before closing date, less office fee and processing fee. After closing date but before move in day, Stalls, camping, & extra bedding. No refunds after Thursday before show. All refunds will be less 5% processing fee. In the unlikely event of show cancellation, refund will be less office fee.

Late Entries: Late entries will be accepted after the closing date if space is available, upon payment of an additional late entry fee of \$40. All late entries must enter and pay online – email for late entry permission.

Policy for Class Changes and Filling Scratches in classes: Must be eligible for class.

Day Trailer parking: Pay per day parking fee and park in areas designated by show management.

Show Management reserves the right to vary or add officials and refuse any entry for a cause; to disqualify any exhibitor and/or his or her horse for cause; to cause an exhibitor to forfeit his or her ribbons and winnings for cause; to return any entry and/or stall fee before or during the show for cause; all without being liable for damage or compensation. Show management reserves the right to make any changes deemed necessary for the safe and efficient conduct of this competition.

Entry Information (cont'd):

Weather/Acts of God/Accidents or Emergency Policy: Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accidents or Emergencies. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to championship classes. No refunds for cancelations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accidents or Emergencies.

No Shows: All "No Shows" that have not contacted the show office will be considered a scratch for the rest of the show and time slots may be filled. Exhibitors enter with this understanding and agreement.

Show Schedule and Ride Time Conflicts: It is the responsibility of the rider to inform the management of any time conflicts upon initial receipt of ride times. If notification is received immediately every effort will be made to alleviate the conflict. However, it is not always possible to accommodate conflicts for coaches who are also competing in the show.

Additional Stabling Information:

- **Stable Group:** Please list stable group on entry form and use only one group name for each stable group to ensure that your group will be stabled together. It may not be possible to satisfy all stabling requests and requests will be granted on a first come basis. Stalls will be ready to use by 12:00 pm on Thursday.
- Any **stall changes MUST** be cleared with show office.
- Trailer-ins must pay daily grounds fee and park in designated areas.
- No early arrivals without prior permission. No Sunday night stabling without prior permission.
- Lungeing in designated areas only.

Pets: Dogs **must be on leashes or otherwise restrained AT ALL TIMES** while on show grounds, including in the stable area. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dogs should not be kenneled overnight in the stable area. Dog owners failing to comply will be fined \$25 per incident.
